### STALLION SERVICE CONTRACT

The Service is Subject to the Following:

1. A booking fee of \$\_\_\_\_\_ of the above fee is payable with this contract and the balance of \$\_\_\_\_\_ plus all unpaid expenses will be payable upon receipt of an invoice or when the mare leaves the farm, whichever is first. Booking fee is not refundable. The Breeder requires 48 hours advance notice when the Mare Owner wishes to remove his mare(s) from the farm. This will allow us sufficient time to prepare the final statement so the Owner may settle his account.
2. The mare will be in healthy and sound breeding condition. If information regarding worming date is not furnished, your mare will be wormed upon arrival and every 60 days thereafter. All dry mares will be cultured and/or biopsied at veterinarian's discretion and appropriately treated.
3. Mares that are not halter broken will not be accepted.
4. 18% interest will be charged on all accounts in excess of thirty days.
5. A photostatic copy of registration papers (both sides), a veterinarian's health certificate, including uterine culture, worming, immunization records, & current Coggins test shall be furnished upon delivery of mare to breeding farm. If these are not presented upon mare's arrival, the Breeder shall have the attending veterinarian make proper test and evaluations at the Mare Owner's expense. Tetanus and sleeping sickness injections shall be administered while the mare is being bred at Mare Owner's expense. Flu and Rhinopneumonitis vaccine must be given before mare arrives.
6. It is my understanding that Edgwood/Lanning, Inc. will not be responsible for accident, sickness, or death to my mare and/or her foal. The owners/management will exercise judgement in the care and supervision for her and/or her foal. It is also understood that I likewise will not be responsible for any disease, accident or injury to the stallion. Edgwood/Lanning, Inc., stallion owners and/or agents will not be liable for any infectious, transmittable or inheritable diseases or conditions to the foal resulting from this breeding.
7. The Owners agree to diligently try to settle my mare. If, however, the mare does not settle, I will hold Edgwood/Lanning, Inc. harmless. There is no live foal guarantee for any mare leaving the breeding farm before checked safe in foal by our attending veterinarian. Any exception to this will be stated in writing and signed by owners or manager.
8. It is further agreed that should the above named stallion die or become unfit for service, or if mare dies or becomes unfit to breed, then this contract shall become null and void.
9. When the owners or managers sign and return one copy of this contract to me, it will be a binding contract on both parties, subject to the terms and conditions of this contract. (Please return the original to Edgwood/Lanning, Inc.)
10. **ALL EXPENSES MUST BE PAID UPON RECEIPT OF STATEMENT AND NO MARE LEAVES WITHOUT BEING PAID IN FULL.**
11. Foaling fee to be charged in the amount of \$350.00 if mare foals at Edgwood/Lanning, Inc.
12. Because of the security of the stallions, our gates will be locked at 7:00 p.m. each night. If you are to arrive later than 7:00 p.m. or before 7:00 a.m., please make previous arrangements by calling stallion manager.
13. Stallion service certificates will be issued only after mare owner has notified stallion manager in writing that the mare has produced a live foal and all bills on the mare have been paid, except that if the mare owner transfers ownership of the mare before foaling, stallion service certificate will be issued upon such transfer when all conditions of this contract have been met to date.
14. **A PHOTOSTATIC COPY, BOTH SIDES THEREOF, OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS ON YOUR MARE MUST ACCOMPANY CONTRACT. OWNER RECORDED ON REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE WILL BE RECORDED ON THE STALLION BREEDING REPORT.**
15. This contract is not transferable or assignable. This contract contains a "Live Foal Guarantee". A live foal is described as a newborn foal which stands and nurses without assistance, period.
16. If your mare and/or foal is insured, fill in the name and telephone number of your agent.

17. All mares must stay at Breeding Farm until pronounced 45 days in foal. All mares must be picked up by July 1, or whenever notified by manager. Our breeding season will end June 30, and no mares will be bred after this date. Mares bred in June may be picked up without the 30-day pregnancy check, but stud fee must be paid in full. You must then get your veterinarian to check your mare 45 days past breeding date and promptly send us a statement stating results of the examination. Live foal guarantee will apply to these mares whether in foal or not in foal. There will be no money refunded.

18. If the mare does not produce a live foal (a foal that stands and nurses without assistance) as a result of the breeding, the stallion owner gives a live foal guarantee and in lieu of all other obligations will give a return breeding the following season not including mare care or veterinarian expenses, subject to the following exceptions and qualifications:

- (a) If the mare is removed from the stallion manager's premises without written certification of pregnancy by the stallion manager's veterinarian, the live foal guarantee will be void unless at the time of such removal the mare has been checked open by such veterinarian and the stallion manager certifies in writing that further breeding efforts will not be made.
- (b) If the mare is checked pregnant by the stallion manager's veterinarian and later aborts or fails to produce a live foal, the live foal guarantee will be void unless the mare owner notifies the stallion owner by telephone or telegram within 48 hours after foaling or aborting and within 15 days thereafter furnishes the stallion manager a certificate by a licensed veterinarian substantiating the abortion or death of the foal and specifying the full particulars as to cause.
- (c) If the mare is checked pregnant by the stallion manager's veterinarian but dies after leaving the stallion manager's premises, the live foal guarantee will be void unless the mare owner notifies the stallion manager by telephone or telegram within 48 hours after the mares death and within 15 days thereafter furnishes a certificate by a licensed veterinarian substantiating the death and specifying full particulars as to cause.

19. Edgwood/Lanning, Inc. shall have possessory lien on mare for all unpaid bills. Mare owners shall be responsible for reasonable attorney's fees and court costs if necessary to collect fees due hereunder.
